RESPONSIBILITIES:

Coordinate outreach/field trips, volunteers, events and alumni relations for the Real Food Rising youth farming program.

Manage and recruit volunteers, coordinate volunteer workdays on our 1.25 acre urban farm for both individuals and groups (~1000 volunteers per year).

Coordinate outreach events and presentations in the community to spread awareness about Real Food Rising, sustainable agriculture, local food systems and nutrition.

Coordinate field trips, train youth interns in leading field trips (April-Oct), and work with farm stand manager to do outreach and marketing for community farm stands (April-Oct).

Coordinate all Real Food Rising community events (Fall Celebration, Community Lunches), assist with donor campaigns (Giving Tuesday in Dec and Love Ut Give Ut in Mar) and coordinate selling produce to wholesale accounts (June-Oct).

Also process youth program applications (spring and fall) and assist with youth interviews (April).

Full-time 40 hours/week/Tuesday-Saturday for 12-months beginning February 2016—January 2017.
